

WINTER OUTLOOK FOR 2022-2023

1. Colder December than last four years.
2. This winter will be colder than last year.
3. More snow than last winter.
4. Will be one of the snowier winters in last 8 years.
5. First 2 inches of snow will occur after December 12.
6. No white Christmas this year (last one was in 2010)
7. Large temperature swings again this year (60 degrees +).
8. Less windy days then last year.
9. Several “clipper” systems this winter.
10. At least one severe weather outbreak
11. Increased chance of ice but odds of a major ice storm look low.
12. At least two record or near record highs this winter.
13. Near normal number of subzero days (average is 3.5), forecast is between 3 and 5.
14. A few “High Impact” storms this winter.
15. More warm days than cold days.
16. January will be colder than normal.
17. Coldest half will be the second half of winter.
18. Most “active” part of winter will be the second half.
19. Still cool to start March.
20. Some snow in March.
21. Heaviest snow in the second half of winter.
22. Could be the coldest winter since 2014-15.
23. Temperatures will be BELOW normal- normal is 32.3 and forecast is 31.4.
24. Precipitation will be BELOW normal- normal is 8.55” and forecast is 7.80”.
25. Snow will be NEAR normal- normal is 14.8” and forecast is 14.5”.
