**INITIAL HEARING ORDER**

The State of Indiana appears by Emily Clarke, Prosecuting Attorney. Defendant appears in person in custody of the Clay County Sheriff's Department. First appearance attorney, Caleb S. Fleschner appears telephonically on behalf of Defendant. The Court advised the Defendant of the formal charges and possible penalties and his rights.

- The Defendant states he/she will hire counsel.  
 The Court appoints Public Defender Matthew Effner (812) 238-4000  
 The Court appoints Public Defender B. Lee Reberger, Jr. (812) 442-0974  
 The Court appoints Public Defender Matthew Neuman (812) 232-3388  
 The Court finds that Defendant is not indigent and should employ his/her own attorney.

Defendant is ordered to cooperate with counsel and appear for all appointments. Failure to do so may result in re-arrest and being held without bond in jail until trial. Defendant is advised that should there be a conviction, you can be ordered to reimburse the County for the costs of your counsel, and that the costs of counsel could be deducted from any cash bond which is posted.

Not Guilty Plea entered. **Pre-trial Conference set JULY 17, 2023 at 1:30 pm**

**Jury Trial set DECEMBER 18, 2023 at 1:30 pm**

The Defendant is ordered held by the Clay County Sheriff pending the posting of bail pursuant to I.C. 35-33-8-3.1. The Court sets bail as follows:

- Defendant is to be held **WITHOUT** bond.  
 No Contact Order  
 Released on own recognizance

Should Defendant post bond, he/she is ORDERED to advise this Court, Prosecutor and Attorney of any change in address, phone number, or email in writing within 48 hours, obey all laws and appear as ordered.
